- Creating a sustainable model to assure continuation of the program wherever implemented
- Presenting the ideas and the program function to whoever would benefit as recipient of the information or show interest in replicating the program in their own setting
- Creating documentation for public dissemination
- Acting as liaison with the William Glasser Institute
- Sharing information about the Choice Theory Connections Program with the William Glasser Institute membership worldwide.
